Whereas Complaint has been lately made to me Stephen Horsey. One of their Majesties Justices of the Peace for the County aforesaid, That One Mary Maywell had sent woman to me Edward Jones, that at sundry times feloniously taken away severall parcels of tobacco from me Blaugmye to me Randall Kobbell & me Miles Gray

These are therefore in their Majesties Names strictly to will & require as also Charge and Command y<sup>e</sup> that hereinafter by some of the Justices of the Peace y<sup>e</sup> have y<sup>e</sup> body of the aforesaid Mary Maywell at our Court house before their Majesties Justices in Court sitting, that shee shall answer as well to the aforesaid Complaint as to what else shall be objected agt her on behalf of their Majesties. fail not at y<sup>e</sup> point & have you this this warrant given under my hand & Seal this 9<sup>th</sup> day of January in y<sup>e</sup> 24<sup>th</sup> year of their Majesties Regn Wm. & Mary King & Queen over England June: Domini 1692.

Warrant Comitted to the aforesaid Mary Burtz at y<sup>e</sup> Court in Court

It was then ordered by the Court that the said Mary Burtz & Evidence appear the next Saturday before Capt. Gen. King & me Stephen Horsey at the sd Horsey's house, that the matter might be further inspected into

Wm. Burtz was y<sup>e</sup> Court ordered into their Custody for want of special Bail to me John Jones these aunts.

Capt. Edward Archer & me Alexander Lyke this day entered into recognizance in Open Court of 100<sup>th</sup> Sterling to be justly indicted to me Nathaniel Horsey

The condition of which recog. is such y<sup>e</sup> if the sd Archer do: with y<sup>e</sup> truly stand to abide, observe, performe, fulfill & keep the shward of two men indifferently chosen to y<sup>e</sup> determine a Suite of Law depending in our sd Court between the said Horsey & Archer. then y<sup>e</sup> recog. void, otherwise to remaine in full power force & virtue

And Gen. West was as aforesaid bound for sd Horsey to sd Archer in 100<sup>th</sup> of Sterling to stand to the shward as aforesaid
