Somers County & Province of Maryland doe acknowledge our selves to stand firmly bound and
justly indebted unto their Majties King Wm & Queen Mary in the full & just sum of thirty
pounds Sterling money for the payment of the same well & truly to be made when & how
required by their Majties Justices of the Peace of the said County wee the persons above named doe
loyntly & severally give & Oblige our selves and Heirs Executors & Adors in the whole & for
whole payment finally & absolutely by virtue of these presents, dated the 21th of May. 1692.

The Condition of the aboves Obligation is such that if the aboves bounden John: Pope
doe make his personall appearance at the Court next to be holden in the said County then & there to answer
before their Majties Justices of the Peace, all & whatsoever, shall be proposed & objected agt him
on their Majties behalf & doe stand & abide the judgment of the said Court relating to all breach of his
Bonds of his behaviour, breaches of the good & wholesome laws of this their Majties Province and
any and all other misdemeanours by him the said John: Pope perpetrated committed & done, then
this Obligation becomes utterly void, but if otherwise then to stand remain & abide in full
force strength & virtue, as witness our hands & Seals the day & year aboves written.
