It is Ordered being read it was then by the worth Court Ordered that Sarah Whitey
 Orphan be kept in Custody of Daniel Elzey till June Court next. Ordered also
 That Daniel Elzey bring to Court the said Sarah while the Court continues. and upon
 the 16th day of March an^o 1693. at request of Mr Samuel Hopkins Esq Comissary It
 was Ordered that Dorcas Whitey Relict of Capt Whitey do appear the day following
 before the Justices in Court sitting. —

And upon the 17th day of March an^o 1693. The sd Dorcas & Sarah both appeared
 in Court, The said Capt Whitey's Will was then Read. The Court demanded of sd Sarah
 where her desire was to live, where reply was at her Brother Daniel Elzey's, where upon
 it was again Ordered that she continue at the sd Daniel Elzey's till June Court.

Like wife by mutuall Consent of Dorcas Whitey Relict of Capt Ringard Whitey
 and the said Sarah Whitey Orphan of the said deceased. It is Ordered by the Court
 in Court sitting that Mr John Dorman & Mr George Dill do take a particular acc^t of
 the Effects of Capt Ring Whitey deceased.
