Shops: Taylor of this County Weaver was
 attached to answer unto John Lowell of the same
 County Townsunder in a plea of trespass upon y^e Case.

Now whereupon the p^t John Lowell by John Braubridge his Attorney Complaineth
 and saith that whereas Mary the wife of the said John Lowell did in or about the
 1st of March last an^o 1691. in the absence of her husband, send a portell of yarn to Worwinstone
 in the jurisdiction of this Court to the said Shops: Taylor to weave & make Cote of the
 number of twelve yards of hems made: Cote valued at six hundred pounds of tobacco Merchants
 as & exempl^r this p^rcedure in Court more plainly may appear, & was to have his pay (viz) a
 pair of Shooes or a Bushell of Ball, for weaving the whole 12 yards. Notwith standing the sd
 Shops: Taylor (as the p^t was credibly informed) sent the forced Cote wite in a month after he
 had rec^d the forced yarn from the forced John Lowell's wife. upon which information the p^t John Lowell
 went to the said Shops: Taylor wite a pair of Shooes being his pay, to pay the said Shops: Taylor for weaving
 the forced Cote. But the Cote was certainly sold by the said Shops: Taylor so that the said Shops: Taylor doth
 unjustly & fraudulently keep & detain from the p^t the forced Cote contrary to law or Equity to
 the ruin & undoing of the said John Lowell his wife & children & poor family, so that the said
 John Lowell is made worse in Estate so that he is damaged & hath damages to the value of 1200
 of Merchants tobacco & two of his Rings that he hath.
