his Court by his Britan. Dill. Obligatory where the said Robert with the Seal of the said
Lawrence signed bringeth into Court, the date whereof is the day & year aforesaid -
acknowledged himself to be bound to the said Robert in the full & just sum of 756. Pounds
of good full Merchantable Lard to be paid to the said Robert on or before the tenth day
of October next ensuing the date of the said Dill. at the dwelling house of Jm. Croft
the late in the County & Debtor aforesaid. Notwithstanding the said Lawrence has so sum
of 6. Pounds of Lard to the said Robert hath not paid, but hath utterly refused & doth
