However the said John the Bignors assumption aforesaid not regarding but minding of fraudulent intenting the said David Drowne of the sum 5486th of the said Bignors & of fraud & of the said sum to pay the said sum although after the same required & demanded, yet saith that is damaged & that damage is the value of 10972 of Mortable lawfull tender of the Bignors this sum. Strawbridge & others prove the same.
