By his Excellency
A Proclamation

Whereas the full Assembly of this Province was on the 9. day of March last postponed
until the twentieth day of this Instant May, which day now drawing near at hand and is
urgent or emergent occasion at present offering which might require the Convening
of the same at the said time, I have with the advice & Consent of their Most Excellent
said Province thought fitt to defer & prorogue the same, and the same is accordingly
further prorogued unto the twentieth day of July next ensuing. Whereof all Singular
Barons of this Province are hereby straightly charged & commanded to make public Proclamations
in the most public & convenient places within their severall respective Counties and also give
due notice to each of their Most Excellent Council as do inhabit & reside within their County, and to
Deputies & Delegates thereof by the free men of the same Province Chosen, that all
Persons so appointed, they and every of them be & personally appear at the City of St. Marys on the said
twentieth day of July next, to do and Consent to such things as shall there be by the favour of
God happen to be Ordained & enacted.

Given at the City of St. Marys under the great Seal of this Province the tenth day of May Anno
Domini 1693 in the fift year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord & Lady King William & Queen Mary
