

Reasons to shew. W. Geo. Willm. now Dill in Court

Why Execution shall not pass upon a judgment obtained by J. Gumbey pot. att. Thomas: James Dill in March 1692 in an action of trespass upon the Case (viz)

1stly That recovery of trespass upon the Case shall be taken therein of, in any Court of Jurisdiction in this Kingdom; but must be lost & upon as null & void in Law after so many years, as in the said Law is limited. & for this to which Law, may further & more at large appear: so that here is an action of trespass upon the Case of near fourteen years standing. ergo null & void.

2dly. Was not ordered age for taking up selling or disposing a Certain herd without Order, knowledge, privity or Consent of the Owner, either by word or writing. if a herd they ought to have had four fold damages, besides the utmost penalty the Law inflicted, so that this Order is no way agreeable thereto. Ergo null & void

3dly That if the Jury & Court did continue, that we had Orders to sell the said herds that then they ought to have only judgment to act; the which was always had been Owners still ready to tender; so that Orders or not Orders this judgment is void.

4thly. It is to be considered, that the Court may be pleased, to grant us an Order for our just and honest account that a Bill may be made upon Record & that we may have our due Course for such many standalls already bound against us. This is for of yo. humble servant.
