The Conditions of the above Recognizance is such that if the above bounden Thomas Williams be of the good Behavior & allegiance to all their Majesties Ledges people of their Kingdoms during the Courts pleasure then the Recognizance to be void & of none effect otherwise to be & remain in full power force & virtue.
