 Linnis. and the said Bartor did at New Bedgum himself owe & indebted to the ...
 Somerset County Court the sum of five thousand pound of Tobacco, & the said W. ...
 at New Bedgum himself to be indebted to the said Court the sum of five & twenty hundred pound of Tobacco
 due to be paid on their goods & Chattels lands & Tenements for the Court use &c.

The Condition of this Recognizance is such that if the above named Bartor Wharfed do well
 & truly perform & pay for fifty days work with dist & tools, when by the Justices of Somerset
 County Court shall demand as also all Court charges, which charges the said Linnis assumed in Court
 to pay. then the Recognizance to be void, otherwise to be remain in full power force & virtue
