The Evidence of Thomas Onalaboll. I was at work with James Darry and he told that he had two Doves out & he did hear that one was at your mill. I told him there was one there but I did not know what it was but if James Dore did come to Darrys & he told me, that he would give me one gallon of rum to kill him & Dore, so I went out but when I saw the Dove I told him I would not kill that Dove but if he would kill him I would help him to dress it, so he shot the Dove on him & shot him down & when the hogg was dead. I went & looked on him & I told him that if he was new of his, & he told me that he bought the marks from Robert Catlin. so I told him that I would put the cards up, so I did nail the cards up as I might as I could with put them against a post & further said net. Sworn before me John: Lucy
June 7th 2nd day: 1692.

The Evidence of Maryjett Tillman. On the fourth day of November last about the sun going down, she heard in Darrys yard say, that there was her father's Dove so presently after I heard him shot the Dove on him, & the hogg was bill of further said net - Sworn before me - - - John: Lucy
June 7th 2nd day: 1692.

The Evidence of Gyson Tillman, that on October last I met with James Darry in the woods, and asked him if my Dove Darrow was at his house & he told me no. And he told him there was a white Dove at my house but I did not know. He said that my Dove & I told him it was new of his, for he was Cripp & shot in the right ear, so upon the fourth day of November I found the Dove out of my Orchard, when my own Dove Darrow came home, & he was killed that night.
