The Complainant Nicholas Carpenter, before his Examination, took y<sup>e</sup> Oath of Fidelity & afterwards when the Evidence was sworn & examined by Edward Ward Gu<sup>o</sup> Barber & Gu<sup>o</sup> Straubridge whose matter being defunct. It was ordered, that whereas a sum of 50 shillings was due to the said Nicholas Carpenter he was ordered to be paid in shillings & pence & carried to Gu<sup>o</sup> W<sup>illiam</sup> of the County where it to pay the said Lord in shillings.
