be granted, & your Petitioner as in duty bound shall ever pray. — not granted

To the Court of Somerset County Court the humble petition of Edmund: Williams
humbly sheweth. That your Petitioner is a very aged & decrepit Person & incapable of
getting his living, your Petitioner therefore humbly prayeth he may be exempted from
paying his tithes and your Petitioner shall pray. — not granted.

Somerset. To the wth their Majesties Justices of the Law for that County in Court sitting
the humble petition of Alexander: Gold humbly sheweth. — That Elizabeth Gold of the
County hath betrothed James: Henderson late of that County deceased, the full time & term
of five years, and by her said Master, in his life time, as also by John: Henderson since the
said James his decease hath been detained in servitude this year & 1/2 longer th without any
satisfaction to the said Elizabeth made: for it is 3 1/2 years, but still the said Elizabeth is
craved her freedom, ~~satisfaction~~ satisfaction for the 3 years & 1/2 servitude with Corn and
Cloth, according to the Custom of the Country. to the great grief & sorrow of heart of your
poor Petitioner, therefore your petitioner craveth your wth to consider your petitioner's daughter's
Case, and that it may be ordered that if wth may order her freedom with Corn and Cloth th satisfaction
your wth shall think fit for the said three years & half, & if your wth as in duty bound shall
ever pray. — — — — — Alexander: Gold.
