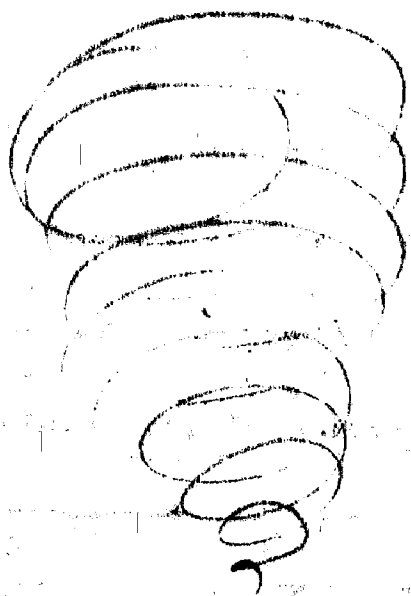


Maryland Court for the County of Anne Arundel. 1692.

Isabell Davison stole from John Cornish. viz

one Ring	120
one gold Ring	200

The aforesaid Isabell Davison appearing did Confess to the Court that she was guilty, and had stolen the particulars above mentioned. where being considered the Court Orders the said Isabell pay four fold to w<sup>ch</sup> John Cornish. which four fold amounts to two thousand and eighty pounds of the same.

Ordered her wife Corporal punishment. viz five lashes upon the bare back of the said Isabell well laid on. which by the Sheriff was executed.

Ordered her wife that Patrick Davison & Isabell his wife give good Security for the aforesaid four fold & Court Charges. Ordered in the Sheriff's custody till her given.

Whereupon came the aforesaid Patrick Davison & Isabell his wife and by Recognizance did Confess them selves to owe & be indebted unto our Sovereign Lord Lady Wm. & Mary King's Queen of England the just sum of ten pound Sterling money of England, due to be satisfied on their goods & Chattels Lands and Estates for their Malice upon the. L<sup>th</sup> wife gave their Security in James Round of Arroy. did likewise become bound in the sum of five pound Sterling in name of James aforesaid the.

The Condition of the above Recognizance is. That if the above bound Patrick Davison & Isabell his wife, do well & truly pay the aforesaid four fold viz 2080 lb<sup>ts</sup> the same, as also be of good behavior to all their Malice Lige People during the Courts pleasure then the Recognizance to be void and of none effect, otherwise to be and remains in full power force and virtue.
