of the said William of 2000 pounds of lawfull money of England his duty.

Know all men by these presents that I Thomas Cullen of Somerset County in the Province of Maryland  
do owe and stand justly indebted unto the said William Cullen of the County of Accomack in Virginia Governor the  
making of twenty pairs of shooes fall shooes for y<sup>e</sup> use of the said William upon demand made the  
said William. Whereby I am, his Honor's Exce<sup>l</sup>lents orderment. Bound unto my Honor's Exce<sup>l</sup>lents to forfeit y<sup>e</sup> making  
of twenty pairs of shooes for y<sup>e</sup> use of the said William in witness whereof. I have hereunto set my hand & seal this  
twenty eighth day of May Anno Domini 1692.

y<sup>e</sup> are in no wise to omit, as y<sup>e</sup> will answer y<sup>e</sup> contrary, Given at our City of St. Mary's, under y<sup>e</sup> great Seal of our said  
Province of Maryland. Witness our selves the 15<sup>th</sup> day of July in y<sup>e</sup> 5<sup>th</sup> year of our reign: Anno Domini 1693.
