The 1st Octo: of the above Obligation is due that if the above bound Thomas. Davis his Heire or other
shall will & truly pay or cause to be paid unto the aforesd Henry Smith his Heire, Executors or Assigns the full & just
sum of three thousand One hundred & Sixty feet of good sound fine Cyprus Blanke. That is to say One thousand &
feet of said Blanke to be paid at or before the 1st day of March ensuing Dous thousand & sixtie feet of said
Blanke to be paid at or before the 1st day of March ensuing the rate of threepence, to be paid off now.
