The condition of the above obligation is such that if the above bounden Wm. Mead Dispayre shall will & truly pay or cause to be paid unto the above bounden David Brown his Heire Excess Dents or dings the just quantity of two thousand four hundred pounds of good sound Merchantable leaf tobacco in Casks to contain the same Concomitent in Moneth or dimesay. Then this present Obligation is to voide of howe & all otherwise to stand & remaine to be in full force power & vertue.

And whereupon the said James by Peter Dowell his Attorney saith that the said John the 15<sup>th</sup> day of April in the year of our Lord 1691: at Moneth within the Jurisdiction of this Court was indebted to the said James as by his certain Bond or writing Obligation, white the said James, with the Seal of the said John signed brought the same into Court the date whereof is the day & year aforesaid at the which time he did owe to the said James in the said full & just summe of 10000 pounds of good sound Merchantable tobacco to be paid to the said James, & the white payment will & truly to be mad: & done the said John bound him selfe jointly by the said Bond. Now therby the said John the same to the said James hath not paid to the damage of the said James of 12000 pounds of tobacco & therof he bring his suit thereto. And the said John: Combs defendeth the firste his injury w<sup>t</sup> me & prayes the hearing the said Bond if it doth to him his prayes also the hearing the Condition of the said Writing & it is wad to him in these words. The Condition of the above Obligation is such that if the above bounden John: Wheeler shall on his part will truly & faithfully shew off serv<sup>e</sup> the above named James Weatherlie his Heire Excess Dents or dings the full sume or term of two years from the date above written in such service & employme as the said James Weatherlie his Heire shall sett him to or employ him in during his said term & shall in all things during the said term in full
