

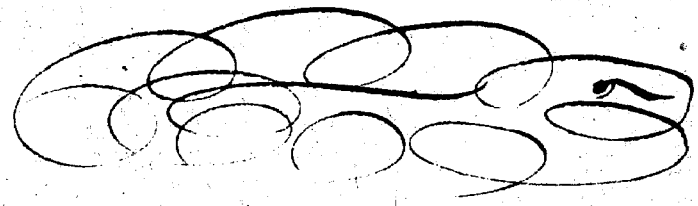

Know all men by these presents that I John Wheeler of the County of Prince Georges a Justice of the Peace do hereby certify that the above named James Weatherly of the County of Prince Georges a Justice of the Peace in the full & just sum of four thousand pounds of good sound Merchants tobacco in Casks to be paid to the said James Weatherly or his true & Lawfull Attorney his Heirs Executors or Assignes on all demands to & when payment will & truly to be made. Given under my Heirs Executors & Assignes seal the 15th day of April in the year of our Lord God 1691.

THE CONDITIONS of the above written obligation is such that if the above bounden John Wheeler shall on his part, well truly & faithfully & honestly serve the above named James Weatherly, his Heirs Executors or Assignes the full time or term of two years from the date above written in such service & employment as the said James Weatherly his Heirs Executors or Assignes shall see him to or employ him in during the said term, and shall in all things to have him self abide stay & bear in all things during the said term in full as is specified & mentioned in a certain Indenture of apprenticeship or servitude for the term aforesaid bearing date with these presents assigned by the above bounden John Wheeler to the above named James Weatherly for his true service or term mentioned it being in & for the consideration of the freedom of two years service of Margaret Strawbridge, the above named James Weatherly's servant maid, that then the above written obligation to be void and to be of none effect or else to abide in full force effect & virtue.

of good Merchants tobacco & Casks Containeth on the Bay Side in the County aforesaid, at or upon the 15th day of October next at witness my hand this 3rd day of March 1690/91.
