Know all men by these presents that I Thomas Quilliams of Somerset County Clerk do hereby by my self & severally acknowledge our debt our debt & extend to stand justly indebted to her Majesty King William & Queen Mary in the full & just sum of four pounds sterling to be paid upon demand upon condition as follows.

The condition of the above obligation is that if y^e above bound Thomas Quilliams do personally appear before the Justices of the Peace at y^e next County Court there to be held to answer y^e complaint of Margarett Gallahoe: then y^e above obligation to be void or else to stand in full power & virtue in Law with my own hand & seal this 21st July 1693

Know all men by these presents that I Margarett Gallahoe do acknowledge my debt to stand justly indebted to her Majesty King William & Queen Mary in the sum of four pounds sterling to be paid upon demand to the presents Thomas Quilliams at the next County Court before the Justices of the Peace for Somerset County & would have forced her to have had the use of her body in a swamp near Danick Dunham's house the 26th June last for which she hath declared upon her Oath and in this protesting the above obligation to be void & of no effect or else to stand in full force & power & virtue in Law with my hand & seal this 21st June 1693

For the forced Warrant & Bonds were read. The Court asked the said Thomas Quilliams if he were guilty or not guilty, he replied not guilty. Whereupon was summoned 15 Jurymen of which were examined, who it did appear to y^e Court that the said Margarett Gallahoe had falsely accused the said Quilliams. And therefore the said Quilliams was dismissed there from, paying his fees. — And the said Margarett Gallahoe for y^e forced abuse was the Court ordered one twenty lashes on her bare back well laid on, for swearing her self free, which was off the Sheriff's custody. Ordered likewise that the said Margarett give security for her good behavior & good that she should have no more of her plantation after she had finished her Crops now in hand. Ordered into the Sheriff's custody till security given & forfeited. — Whereupon came the said Margarett Gallahoe with her two servants (viz) Jonathan Towser & Daniel
