INTRODUCTION OF BILLS.

By Mr. Milbourne,

A bill entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments, sections 7, 9 and 10 of Article 72, of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, title 'Oysters,' sub-title 'Culling,' and to add to said Article 72, four new sections to be known as 'Sections 69, 70, 71 and 72 of said Article,' providing for the appointment of a Shell Fish Commissioner, and defining his duties."

Which was read the first time and referred to the Committees on Chesapeake Bay and Ways and Means.

By Mr. Linthicum,

A bill entitled "An Act to incorporate Baltimore Electric Light and Power Company of Baltimore city."

Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Corporations.

By Mr. Drumm,

A bill entitled "An Act to have all articles made in penal institutions marked 'Prison Made,' and providing for a penalty for selling such articles not so marked and to add a new section to Article 27 of the Code of Public General Laws, title 'Crimes and Punishments,' to follow section 229 to be known under the sub-title 'Prison Made Articles,' and to be designated as section 229 A."

Which was read the first time, and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary.
