Which was read the first time and referred to the Talbot delegation.

House bill, File No. 397, entitled "An Act to repeal chapter 272 Acts of General Assembly of 1902, entitled 'An Act to prohibit the sale of spirituous or fermented liquor or lager beer, within one mile of white public school No. 4, in the Fifth Election District of Anne Arundel.'"

Which unfavorable report was adopted.

Also unfavorably,

House bill, File No. 411, entitled "An Act to repeal section 5 of chapter 6 of the Acts of the General Assembly, passed at the January session 1894, entitled 'An Act to repeal chapter 423, Laws of 1892,' entitled 'An Act to repeal the sale and the granting of license for the sale of spirituous and fermented liquors in Carroll county, and to re-enact the same with amendments,' and to re-enact the same with amendments."

Which unfavorable report was adopted.
