Which was read the first time, and referred to the Howard delegation and Mr. Ray.

HOUSE OF DELEGATES,

The following Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, originating in the House of Delegates, were presented to the Governor this day for his approval :

Chapter 109. "An Act to require all railroad companies and corporations, and all persons running or operating cars or coaches by steam on any railroad line or track in the State of Maryland for the transportation of passengers, to provide separate cars or coaches for white and colored passengers, without any difference or discrimination in the quality of or convenience or accommodation in such cars and coaches."

Chapter 110. "An Act to provide for separate accommodations for white and colored passengers in the sitting, sleeping and eating apartments of all steamboats plying in the waters within the jurisdiction of the State of Maryland, without any difference or discrimination in the quality or convenience of accommodation."

Chapter 111. "An Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments sections 193, 194, 197, 202 and 207 of Article 17 of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled
