A bill entitled "An Act to incorporate the Baltimore Construction and Investment Company."

Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Corporations.

A bill entitled "An Act to require the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Charles county to make a general index of the Chattel Records of Charles county from the year 1880 and to keep a general index of such records hereafter."

Which was read the first time and referred to the Charles delegation.

By Mr. Williams,

A bill entitled "An Act to require all street, electric or cable railroad companies and all persons running or operating cars propelled by electricity or cable in the State of Maryland, for transportation of passengers, to provide separate cars for white and colored passengers without any discrimination or difference in the quality or convenience or accommodation in such cars."

Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary.

A bill entitled "An Act to enlarge the powers and amend the charter of the Jacob Tome Institute, a corporation incorporated under the General Incorporation Laws of this State, and whose charter was amended
