Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary.

A bill entitled "An Act to repeal sections 205 to 213 both inclusive of Article 6, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title 'Caroline County,' sub-title 'Roads,' and sections 1 and 2 of Article 25, of the Code of Public General Laws, title 'County Commissioners,' and all other laws so far as said sections and laws may be inconsistent with the provisions of this Act, and providing for the submission thereof to the qualified voters of Caroline county at the election to be held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday of November, 1904."

Which was read the first time and referred to the Caroline delegation and Mr. Butler.
