House bill, File No. 499, entitled "An Act to add a new section to Article 4 of the Code of Public Laws of Maryland, title 'City of Baltimore,' sub-title 'Charter,' said section 87 of said Article, and to be known as 'Section 87 A,' relating to the powers of the Water Board."

Also favorably,

House bill, File No. 112, entitled "An Act to repeal section 745 D of Article 4, 'City of Baltimore,' of the Code of Public Local Laws sub-title 'Police Commissioners,' as enacted by chapter 16, of the Acts of 1900, and to re-enact the same with amendments."

Which was read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.
