House bill, File No. 75, entitled "An Act to prohibit the laying of railway tracks upon Evergreen Terrace, between Fulton avenue and Orem lane or avenue, in the city of Baltimore, without the consent of the General Assembly of Maryland."

Endorsed: "Read the third time, and passed by yeas and nays."

Also,

House bill, File No. 21, entitled "An Act to make valid tax sales in the city of Baltimore, made by one city collector and reported, and the property conveyed by his successor in office, or made and reported by one city collector and the property conveyed by his successor in office."

Also,

House bill, File No. 115, entitled "An Act to authorize and direct the Board of Police Commissioners of the city of Baltimore to pension Jacob Frey, formerly Marshal of Police of Baltimore city."

Also,

House bill, File No. 537, entitled "An Act to prevent any person from removing and bringing any poor, indigent or insane persons from any State, county or town, into Garrett county, with the intent to have such person a charge and burden to Garrett county."

Endorsed: "Read the third time, and passed by yeas and nays."

Also,

House bill, File No. 319, entitled "An Act placing as a contingent fund, at the disposal of the Governor (as contemplated in section 32, Article 3 of the Constitution of Maryland), the sum of two hundred and fifty thousand (\$250,000) dollars for the relief of cases of destitution and need caused by the fire in Baltimore of February 7th and 8th, 1904."
