A bill entitled "An Act to add additional sub-section to section 7, Article 49, of the Code of Public General Laws, title 'Interest and Usury,' to be known as 'Sections 7 A, 7 B and 7 C,' to provide for the prevention of usury and extortion.'"

Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary.

A bill entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments section 5 of chapter 189 of the Acts of 1902, entitled 'An Act to repeal sections 202 to 215, of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title 'Worcester County,' sub-title 'Pocomoke City.'"

Which was read the first time and referred to the Worcester delegation.

A bill entitled "An Act to make all ground rents and other charges of land hereafter created in the State of Maryland, subject to taxation and to do away with certain covenants in lease and other instruments of conveyance, hereafter executed in this State."•

A bill entitled "An Act to incorporate the Atlantic and Pacific Trust and Guarantee Company of Maryland."
