House bill, File No. 313, entitled "An Act to provide for an election to be held in Election District No. 8 of Worcester county, to determine by a ballot of the qualified and registered voters in said district, whether spirituous, fermented or intoxicating liquors of whatever origin, or alcoholic bitters shall be sold therein."

Which unfavorable report was adopted.

House bill, File No. 561, entitled "An Act authorizing the Baltimore, Sparrows Point and Chesapeake Railway Company to build bridges across North Point creek and Shallow creek in Baltimore county."

Mr. Keys, from Committee on Roads and Highways, reported favorably, with proposed amendments,
