House bill, File No. 689, entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments section 68 of Article 27, Code of Public General Laws, title 'Crimes and Punishments,' sub-title 'Drunkenness and Disorderly Conduct,' as re-enacted by chapter 215 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at January Session 1902."

House bill, File No. 475, entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments section 116 of Article 16, of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, title 'Chancery,' sub-title 'Partition,' as amended by Acts of 1900, chapter 205."
