Which was read the first time, and referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.

A bill entitled "An Act to prohibit the issuing of any license for the sale of spirituous or fermented liquors or lager beer at any place in Petersville Election District No. 12 in Frederick county, except in the village of Knoxville in the said district, and to prevent the sale of all kinds of intoxicating drinks in the above described limit."

A bill entitled "An Act to amend section 5, of Article 15 of the Constitution of this State, and to provide for the submission of said amendment to the qualified voters of this State for adoption or rejection."

A bill entitled "An Act to repeal section 25, Article 5 of the Code of Public General Laws, title 'Appeals and Errors,' sub-title 'Appeals from Courts of Equity.'"

A bill entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments section 9 of Article 6, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title 'Caroline County,' sub-title 'Almshouse,' and to add three new sections to the said Article 6, to be known as 'Section 9 A and 9 B,' to
