Edgar."

Senate bill, File No. 268, entitled "An Act to repeal section 133 G of the Code of Public Local Laws, title 'Queen Anne's County,' new sub-title 'County Treasurer,' as enacted by chapter 310, of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, of the year 1902, and to re-enact said section 133 G with amendments, and to repeal all laws inconsistent with this Act."
