House bill, No. 267, entitled “An Act to repeal section 198, 199, 210 C, 210 D and 210 G, of the Code of Public Local Laws, Article 20, title ‘Somerset County,’ sub-title ‘Princess Anne,’ as amended by the Acts of 1894, chapter 543, and to re-enact the same with amendments.”

House bill, File No. 410, entitled “An Act to add a new section to Article 3, of the Code of Public Local Laws of the State of Maryland, title ‘Baltimore County,’ sub-title ‘County Commissioners,’ regulating the imposition of taxes in Baltimore county, said section to be known as ‘Section 33 B.’”

House bill, File No. 533, entitled “An Act to repeal sections 182 D, 182 E, 182 F, 182 G and 182 H, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title ‘Washington County,’ sub-title ‘Hagerstown,’ as enacted by chapter 171 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, at the January session of the year 1896, and to re-enact with amendments said section 182 D, so as to read, hereinafter set forth, providing for the payment by the Mayor and Council of Hagerstown of its portion of the cost of paving of any street, lane or alley, or part thereof.”
