House bill, File No. 513, entitled "An Act to empower the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to make appropriations for certain purposes out of any unappropriated balance of the sum of four million, four hundred and twenty-two thousand, four hundred and sixty dollars and seventy-four cents (\$4,422,460.74) formerly part of the purchase price paid by the Fuller Syndicate for the interests of the city of Baltimore in the Western Maryland Railroad Company, and heretofore passed to the credit of the general sinking fund of said city, and the interest accumulated or to accumulate thereon."

House bill, File No. 29, entitled "An Act to add an additional section to Article 43, of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, title 'Health,' to be numbered 'Section 81 B.'"

House bill, File No. 336, entitled "An Act to license and regulate the business of Private Detectives, Detective Agencies in the city of Baltimore."

House bill, File No. 141, entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments chapter 525 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, session 1900, to repeal section 745 of Article 4 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title 'City of Baltimore,' subtitle 'Police Commissioners,' as said section was enacted by said chapter 425 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, 1900, and to re-enact the same with amendments."
