

sell, lease or otherwise dispose of, to the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, the property of the State of Maryland or any interest therein, situated within certain territorial limits in the city of Baltimore.”

Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.

By Mr. Downs,

A bill entitled “An Act to repeal sections 112, 112 A and 113 of Article 2 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title ‘Anne Arundel County,’ sub-title ‘County Commissioners,’ as the same were enacted by chapter 13 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, at the session of 1901, and to re-enact said sections 112 and 112 A, with amendments, fixing the number and compensation of the County Commissioners of Anne Arundel county, and to fix the limit and determine the term of office of the County Commissioners that shall hereafter be elected or appointed perpetuating succession to same, and repealing all laws so far as they are inconsistent with the provisions of this Act.”

Which was read the first time and referred to the Anne Arundel delegation.

A bill entitled “An Act to repeal section 126 of Article 5 of the Code of Public Laws, title ‘Calvert County,’ sub-title ‘State’s Attorneys,’ and to re-enact the same with amendments.”

Which was read the first time and referred to the Calvert delegation.

By Mr. Tighe,

A bill entitled “An Act to add an additional section to be known as ‘Section 177 A,’ and to come immediately after section 177 of Article 17 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title ‘Prince George’s County,’ and repeal and to re-enact with amendments section 178 of said Article 17, Code of Public Local Laws.”

Which was read the first time and referred to the Prince George’s delegation.

A bill entitled “An Act to add an additional section
