A bill entitled "An Act to provide for the better protection of sheep, poultry and game in the Fourth Election District of Queen Anne's county and known as 'Kent Island District' and if possible to make provisions for the reduction of the number of dogs and bitches to a minimum in said Fourth Election District of Queen Anne's county."

A bill entitled "An Act to authorize and direct the Treasurer to pay certain retired school teachers as provided in section 53 A, chapter 196 of the Acts 1902."
