By Mr. Johnston,

In section 47, strike out "five thousand" whenever it occurs in said section and insert "seventy-five hundred."

Which was adopted.

By Mr. Wells,

Amendment proposed to printed bill 449, to add a new section to come after section 71 and to be known as "Section 40 A."

"40 A. To the Trustees of Old School, commonly known as the 'Bladensburg Academy, of Bladensburg, Prince George's county, Maryland,' the sum of two thousand dollars for building, furniture and maintenance."

Which was adopted.

By Mr. Roth,

Amend by adding an additional section as follows: "To the Baltimore University School of Medicine the sum of two thousand dollars for the fiscal year 1905, and the like sum of two thousand dollars for the fiscal year 1906.

Amend by inserting after item 83 the following:

"Item 84. To Normal School No. 2 of Frostburg, Maryland, \$5000 for the fiscal year 1905, and \$5000 for
