Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary.

Senate bill, File No. 383, entitled 'An Act to add two sections to Article 22 of the Public Local Laws of the State of Maryland, title 'Washington County,' sub-title 'Williamsport,' to be known as 'Sections 411 A and 411 B,' to follow section 411 of said Article, as repealed and re enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland of 1904, chapter —, and approved February 25th, 1904, and give additional powers to the Burgess and Commissioners of Williamsport relating to the streets and public places, and the lighting of said town."
