House bill, File No. 317, entitled “An Act to add an additional section to Article 12 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title ‘Garrett County,’ sub-title ‘Justices of the Peace and Constables,’ defining the jurisdiction of Justices of the Peace, said section to be designated as ‘Section 135 A.’ ”

Endorsed: “Read the third time, and passed by yeas and nays.”

House bill, File No. 456, entitled “An Act to repeal section 17, Article 53, of the Code of Public General Laws, title ‘Landlord and Tenant,’ as repealed and re-enacted by the Act of 1880, chapter 310, exempting certain articles from distress for rent and to re-enact the same with amendments.”

Endorsed: “Read the third time, and passed by yeas and nays.”

House bill, File No. 414, entitled “An Act to provide for the burial of paupers in Montgomery county, and for the payment of the expenses thereof, by the County Commissioners of said county, directing what proof shall be furnished before said expenses shall be paid.”
