cation by him of three thousand copies thereof, fifteen hundred copies for use in the public schools of the State, five hundred copies for the members of the Legislature, and one thousand copies for the use and information of the people of the State; three hundred and fifty dollars or as much thereof as shall be necessary, supported by vouchers, to be filed with the Comptroller."

In section 3, line 2, strike out "six" and insert "five."

By Mr. Stump,

In line 276, after the word "dollars," strike out the words "or so much thereof as may" and in line 277, strike out the words "be necessary."

By Mr. Lipman,

Amend by inserting after the word "dollars" the words "for the salary of a Medical assistant to the State Board of Health one thousand dollars."
