Senate bill, File No. 266, entitled "An Act to repeal chapter 410 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the session of 1902, regulating the closed season for hunting in Anne Arundel and Prince George's counties, and to re-enact the same with amendments."

AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

"Provided, however, that one-half of the annual salary of the said treasurer shall not be paid unto him until an auditing of his books and collections has taken place. Said audit shall be made by an auditor
