late electric installation and construction of every description in the city of Baltimore and Baltimore county, and to prevent incompetent persons from doing contracting to do, or engaging in any such work and to provide for the appointment of a commission to supervise and enforce the provisions hereof."

Amendments adopted.

Which was read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.
