Mr. Harvey, from Select Committee, reported favorably, with amendments,

House bill, File No. 46, entitled "An Act to prohibit the sale of spirituous or fermented liquors or lager beer at any place in Garrett county, within three and one-half miles of Fairview Church, in Election District No. 8."

AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

In section 1, on parts of lines 6 and 7, strike out the words "three and one-half miles," and insert the words "three miles."

Which was read the second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

Mr. Feaga from Select Committee reported favorably,

House bill File No. 58, entitled "An Act to provide for a General Index of the Equity Records of Allegany county from the year 1816 to July 1, 1904.

Which was read a second time and ordered to be engrossed for third reading.

INTRODUCTION OF RESOLUTIONS.

Mr. Cockey offered the following Joint Resolution: Requesting the Senators and Representatives of Maryland in the Congress of the United States to use their utmost endeavors to secure the passage at the present session of Congress of the House of Representatives, bill No. 4508, known as the Brownlow bill, entitled "An Act to create in the Department of Agriculture a bureau to be known as the Bureau of Public Roads," and to provide for a system of National, State and local co-operation in the permanent improvement of the public highways.

Which was read a first time and referred to Committee on Federal Relations.
