be known as 'Section 228 A,' under a new sub-title of 'Fraud on Livery Stable Keepers,' providing for the punishment of persons hiring horses or vehicles from livery stable keepers in Dorchester county, to go a certain distance, and using said horses or vehicles for a greater distance."
