

Mr. Keys, from the Committee on Roads and Highways, reported without recommendation,

House bill, File No. 810, entitled "An Act to add an additional section to Article 3, Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title 'Baltimore County,' sub-title 'Roads,' to follow immediately after section 188, as enacted by chapter 685 of the Act of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the January session of 1900, and to repeal and re-enact with amendments, section 196 of said Article, title and sub-title as enacted by said chapter."

House bill, File No. 275, entitled "An Act regulating the loan of money, when as security for such loan, a lien is taken upon household furniture and effects, musical instruments, typewriters and sewing machines in use or located in any dwelling house, by repealing and re-enacting with amendments section 7 of Article 49 of Code of Public General Laws, title 'Interest and Usuary,' as the same was re-enacted by chapter 404 of the Acts of the General Assembly, passed at its January Session, in the year 1902."

Senate bill, File No. 232, entitled "An Act to protect citizens of Maryland from certain communicable diseases especially tuberculosis of the lungs and larynx."
