

House bill, File No. 845, entitled "An Act to add a new section to Article 65 of the Code of Public General Laws, title 'Militia,' sub-title 'Reserve Militia and General Staff,' to follow section 6, and to be designated as 'Section 6 A,' providing for making a Roster of all Maryland soldiers who were in service prior to 1861."

AMENDMENTS PROPOSED.

In section 1, line 1, 6 A, strike out the words "and Governor conjointly are" and substitute the word "is."

In line 2, strike out the word "additional."

In line 6 after the word "expenses," add the following, "such sum to be appropriated out of money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated."

Upon recommendation referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.
