AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

Section 5. Strike out all of section 5 and insert the following: “Be it further enacted, That the said corporation shall have the power to examine buildings, appraise same and their contents, make drawings, plans and inventories, preserve records of the same, audit buildings accounts, adjust losses, make up notices and proofs of losses, keep duplicate of insurance policies of life insurance, contract or indemnity insurance, contract of casualty insurance and any other form of insurance contracts, audit accounts of individuals, firms and corporation, and do any work for the protection of the assured.”
