AMENDMENTS PROPOSED.

Strike out all after the words "A Bill" and substitute the following in lieu thereof:

"Entitled 'An Act to repeal section 289 B, Article 11 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title 'Frederick County,' sub-title 'Justices of the Peace and Constables,' and to re-enact the same with amendments, to be known as 'An Act regulating the compensation of the Police Justice in Election District No. 25, in Frederick county, Maryland.'"

"Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That section 289 B, Article 11 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title 'Frederick County,' sub-title 'Justices of the Peace and Constables,' be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments so as to read as follows:

"289 B. The Police Justice of the Peace for Election District No. 25 of Frederick county, provided for in the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland creating said election district No. 25 passed at the January Session, 1904, shall be paid by the County Commis-
