Senate bill, File No. 380, entitled "An Act to declare the sanction and consent of the General Assembly of Maryland, to sundry gifts, bequest and devises contained in the last will and testaments of certain persons deceased, and also to certain gifts, grants, sales, leases and deeds made by various persons to and for the use and benefit of sundry ministerial persons, religious corporations, educational institutions, denomination or sects, and to certain charitable institutions hereinafter named."

Which was read the second time.

Also favorably,

Senate bill, File No. 305, entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments Article 80 of the Code of Public General Laws of the State of Maryland, title 'Reporter-State,' and re-enacting the same with amendments, under title 'State Reporter and Codifier,' and to provide for the edition and publication of the reports of the Court of Appeals of Maryland, and compilation and publication of a Code of Public General Laws and Public Local Laws of the State of Maryland."

Which was read the second time.

Also favorably,

Senate bill, File No. 427, entitled "An Act to add an additional section to Article 23 of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, title 'Corporations, General Regulation,' to follow immediately after section 85 L of said Article, and to be known as 'Section 85 L one (1) of said Article, relating to the liability of stockholders to creditors and depositors of safe deposits, trust, guarantee, loan and fidelity companies.'"

Which was read the second time.

Also favorably,

House bill, File No. 852, entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments section 7 of Article 11 of the Code of Public General Laws, title 'Banks,' sub-title 'Unclaimed Dividends and Deposits.'"
