House bill, File No. 184, entitled "An Act to prevent the sale of spirituous or fermented liquors or lager beer within a certain area of territory of Baltimore city, in the State of Maryland."

Which was read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

Mr. Benson, from Committee on Corporations reported unfavorably,

House bill, File No. 740, entitled "An Act to prevent the overcrowding of street cars in Baltimore city."

Which unfavorable report was adopted.

Also favorably,

Senate bill, File No. 336, entitled "An Act to amend and extend the charter of the Caroline County Savings Bank, Caroline county, Maryland, and to change the name of the same."

Which was read the second time
