House bill, File No. 660, entitled "An Act to amend the charter of the Kee Mar College of Washington county, Maryland, a corporation duly incorporated under the General Laws of Maryland, by changing its corporate name and adding powers thereof."

House bill, File No. 318, entitled "An Act to authorize and empower the County Commissioners of Talbot county, in the State of Maryland, in their discretion to construct a bridge across Roll's Creek in Talbot county."

House bill, File No. 498, entitled "An Act to authorize and direct the County Commissioners of Montgomery county to construct a stone pike road over the county road between the town of Kensington in said county not less than 12 feet wide and to borrow money therefor issue bonds and to levy and collect from the taxable property in the Fifth Election District of said county an annual tax sufficient to pay said bonds and interest."

House bill, File No. 636, entitled "An Act to prevent the obstruction of the sidewalks of the streets, lanes and alleys of Baltimore city, and for that purpose to repeal the paragraph entitled 'Buildings' of section 6, entitled 'General Powers' of Article 4, entitled 'City of Baltimore,' of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, as enacted by chapter 123 of the Acts of the General Assembly, passed at the January session, in the year 1898; and also to repeal section 8
